She teaches collaborative workshops for all ages and specializes in creating decorative papers with Akua Liquid Pigments. She actively exhibits her work internationally and nationally; Tate Britain Museum, London England, CBK Amsterdam Gallery, Netherlands, Guanlan Art Museum, Shenzhen, China, National Taiwan Museum of Fine Arts, Center for the Book Arts, Minneapolis, MN, Chelsea Art Museum, NYC.
